Every signature counts, and we welcome your help, even if it involves only one or two more signatures. Here are some instructions for taking care of the attached petitions.

- 1) It is perfectly OK to get only one or two signatures on a page. Don't worry about filling a page.
- 2) Feel free to make copies and pass them on to friends who might sign. Or email us at camplongacres@yahoo.com (link on the www.oneaurora.org website), and we can email you copies of the petition and this page.

TAKE THIS VIRAL! Pass this email on to anyone you think might help and ask them to pass it on again.

- 3) Be sure that people signing the petition also clearly print their name under their signature.
- 4) Be sure that the person signing the bottom of the petition as a witness has actually witnessed each person's signature on that page. This is why we make the point that it is OK to have only a few signatures on a page or even only one per page. Don't pass petition pages around so that different people would have to witness signatures on a page. Let each person circulating a petition keep track of their own pages and witness them.
- 5) Anytime you get a few new signatures, you can send the page to Tom at oneaurora.org (address at bottom of this page). Or you are welcome to hold onto them until you get more.
- 6) We welcome your suggestions.
